WHAT WE OFFER



Recovery Support Services: Coordinators can help you find recovery support in the forms of: recovery meetings, sober living, peer support, and recovery coaching.



Treatment Referrals: Coordinators can help you with referrals or facilitate treatment. Treatment is individualized and can be detox, residential, intensive outpatient, or outpatient care. It is supervised by professional providers who may or may not take insurance.



Education: Coordinators speak across Tennessee educating their audiences about recovery, addiction and prevention. Education may come in the form of speaking to businesses, conferences, community groups, jails, schools or treatment facilities.
